



Project Study Area Map

Caton Farm-Oak-Bruce-Gougar







- Based on insufficient financial resources currently available to complete the entire

Municipal Coordination for Future Project Phases

- Following completion of the OINCC analysis, discussions were conducted with the Village of Crest Hill, Homer Township, Lockport Township and the City of Lockport regarding funding and sponsorship of the project
- At this time, none of the agencies are able to be a project sponsor or contribute financially or logistically
- Will County does not have jurisdiction over any of the roadways along the preferred alignment and does not have the capacity to be the project sponsor



Current Status

- The County has been unable to obtain a project sponsor for the next phases of this project.
- The County itself does not have jurisdiction over any roads within the project corridor, and does not have the means or funds to become the project sponsor at this time.
